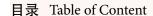

全美华人美术教授协会各位同仁,

过去蛇年的迂回曲折给我们留下了深刻的记忆,<mark>新春马年</mark>的轻步疾蹄给我们展望了美好的前程。值此中国新年之际,我们<mark>执行委员</mark>会的全体委员向大家拜年,祝大家身体健康,事业有成,马到成功!

非常高兴由段炼教授主编的第一期《通讯》和大家见面了<mark>,感谢段炼的杰</mark>出才华和默默付出,这是为我们自己服务的刊物,希望大家<mark>多关心,呵</mark>护,积极参与投稿。

去年我们庄重地承诺了大家赋予的义务和责任,我们一直思考如何在<mark>短短两年任期里把全美华人美术教授协</mark>会做好,在力所能及的情况下为了下一届委员会和今后的协会铺平道路。现在就我们全体委员两个月来的工作向大家做一个报告。

自从去年11月28日宣布正式启用"全美华人美术教授协会"的名字,我们收到非常热烈的反响,同时也积极努力办理注册和申报等法律手续。目前我们已向新泽西州和联邦政府注册,让我们有了一个合法的华人美术教授组织。我们有了自己的家,总部设在230 Garside, Wayne, New Jersey, 我们欢迎大家有机会来总部参观和访问。我们申请了基金,目前中华文化基金会(Chinese Culture Foundation)已承诺给我们\$2,000的启动资金。去年我们参与的"中美高等美术教育研讨会纪要"已于中国艺术研究院《美术研究》2014年第一期发表,我们协会的名字第一次在中国艺术理论界最有权威的刊物上亮相。我们协会的《通讯》还要成立编委会,如果找到赞助,我们希望将来能创立自己的杂志和刊物。

我们委员会通过了由龚嘉伟教授起草,大家修改过的章程草案。有关组织结构问题,我们希望该协会是一个自由和民主的学术机构。作为成员来去自由,参加学术活动自主;每个会员都有选举权和被选举权。执行委员会两年一届,可以连任或再任,最多两届为限。我们还计划邀请和组建顾问委员会和学术委员分会,具体细节请审阅我们《通讯》刊登的章程草案。你们有任何建议和意见,请寄给嘉伟或给我。

我们要特别向大家报告的是:由于个人的原因,王晓苗教授提出不能胜任的辞呈。我们感谢晓苗参与和见证我们委员会的初创工作,特别是新近筹划展览和网站设计,大家一致肯定晓苗的工作和贡献。考虑到增补委员的民选问题和实际集会的困难,征得上届工作委员会主任谭莹教授和汪伊达教授的意见以及关志民教授本人的同意,我提名由上届民选的委员关志民教授补选本届委员,执行委员会已一致投票通过。 欢迎志民和我们一起为大家工作和服务!我们具体分工调整如下:张宗帆教授分工行政和财务监督;段炼教授分工宣传和《通讯》主编;龚嘉伟教授负责组织和网站;关志民教授负责学术和活动策划;我是统筹调度,日常管理和跑后勤。

有关网页和徽标,嘉伟正在努力筹划。我们计划成立一个网络和协会徽标设计委员会,由嘉伟负责组建和征集设计草案。他将很快和你们中间有才 华和有兴趣的教授联系。

有关今年的学术项目,我们几个委员都在积极寻找机会,筛选适合我们要求,时间和资金允许的项目。宗帆到台湾谈到我们在台湾举办展览的机会,嘉伟讲到在他的所在大学德克萨斯展览和举办学术活动的可能,志民说到在中西部举办展览和学术活动的构想。目前我们优先考虑和比较成熟的项目是计划今年11月13日 - 25日在纽约曼哈顿亚洲文化中心美术展览馆和在新泽西威廉帕特森大学举办全美华人教授美术展览,艺术教学示范和东西艺术比较研讨会,同时配合中国文化部的"跨越太平洋 - 与大师面对面"项目,邀请中国著名艺术家和艺术教育家来参加我们的研讨会(具体计划还在策划之中)。这个活动将由全美华人美术教授协会,新泽西威廉帕特森大学中国艺术中心和亚洲文化中心等联合主办,有关展览画册的资金一万五千美元和纽约市展览场地资金都已经得到落实,一旦正式立项和有关部门的批复,我们立即启动,届时敬请大家积极参加。明年我们计划到美国南部,后年到北部聚会。你们有建议和想法请和志民或我联系。

祝贺刚刚组建和成立的《穿越分界论坛》顾问委员会。我们希望全美华人美术教授协会的成员能有宽广的胸襟,包容和理解,支持和参与《论坛》顾问委员会的活动。我喜欢刘虹教授讲的一句话,"有的时候回顾一下我们兴办事务的初衷,可以对目前的状态有更清楚的认识。"我们希望将协会办成:创造全美华人美术教授展示自己艺术作品和介绍自己学术成就的一个窗口;提供学术讨论和交流艺术创作经验的平台;和促进中美艺术教育比较研究和东西文化和艺术交流的一座桥梁。"。本着这样的宗旨,我们对把本届委员会的工作做好充满了信心。 衷心感谢大家对我们的新一届委员会的信任,鼓励,支持和参与。

### 全美华人美术教授协会章程(草案初稿)

#### 宗旨

全美华人美术教授协会是服务于美洲华人高等美术教育界的一个非盈利的专业学术组织。协会将通过举办艺术展览、课程示范、学术交流、艺术访问,以及专题研讨会等多种活动为成员创造展示艺术作品和介绍学术成就的机会和窗口;提供学术研究,艺术创作和艺术教学经验交流的平台; 维护华人美术教授在全美的正当权益;深化比较艺术和比较艺术教育学科的研究,架设沟通中西文化艺术和艺术教育的桥梁,增进中美人民之间的理解。

#### 组织结构

#### 协会成员

- 所有北美高校现任或曾任美术教学与美术研究教职的华人(包含访问学者和客座教授)都是本协会的服务对象,都具备成员资格(主动声明不参与本协会的人员除外。)
- •每个会员都具有参与协会内部事务的讨论、执行委员会的遴选,和向协会建议活动项目与计划的平等资格和权利,同时也有遵守章程和服务协会的义务。

#### 执行委员会

- •执行委员会是协会运行的行政管理机构,执行委会由五名成员组成。执行委员会委员包括主席,宣传发展,组织执行,学术活动,行政财务监督。
- •执委会成员的人选由前任执委会或协会会员推荐,亦可以通过自我提名,经过参

加协会会议的会员投票产生。如会员不能到会,可以书面委托其他会员代为投票。委员任期两年,连任不超过一届。

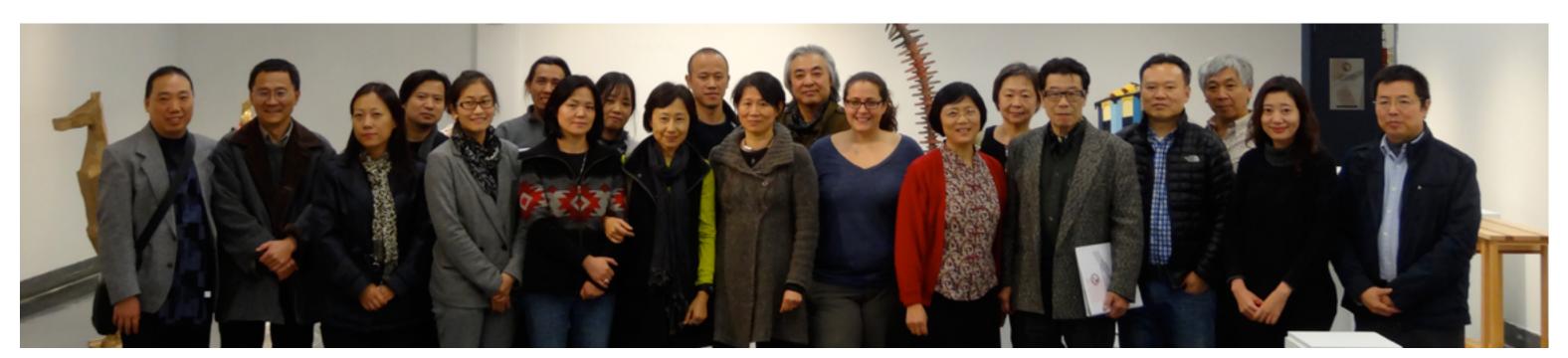
- •执行委员会委员主席必须是委员会成员,在协会会员会议上提名,集体投票选举产生。协会主席负责主持协会日常工作,对协会的方针和政策决定没有特权,与其他执行委员会成员享收平等投票权利。协会的重大决定必须广泛征求协会成员意见后,由执行委员会投票的多数票决定。对于特别重大活动的举行、协会组织结构和性质的变更、关键政策条款的修改,以及执行委员会成员的人选都需要经过会员会议投票,由投票多数产生有效。
- 执委会的职责包括拟定和修改协会章程,制定和执行活动计划,筹措和申请基金,组织和网络运行,邀请和提名顾问委员会,创建新的工作委员会,推选下届执行委员会。
- •执行委员会必须对顾问委员会和协会大会提供年终报告,项目执行报告和财务预算报告。对于使用协会筹募的基金,本届委员会换届时的结余的部分,必须全部移交给下届委员会作为协会专业活动使用。任何个人不得占有和挪作他用。

#### 顾问委员会

- •顾问委员会将由国际艺术大师和艺术教育家、筹款和基金捐助人,以及前任执委会成员担当的管理顾问三部分成员组成。顾问委员会由会员提名,执行委员会任聘、任期和本届执行委员会同期,但不受年限限制,可以连聘连任。
- •顾问委员会的职责是提供协会方针、策略指导,监督和审查协会计划和报告,协助筹措基金,帮助制定协会计划及日常运行管理。

#### 学术委员会

•全美华人美术教授协会,可根据学科的不同,分设学术委员分会。该分会可由协会会员申请,报经执行委员会批准。学术委员会通常由3名委员,其中包括委员会主任组成。学术委员会分会向执行委员会报告工作。



### **Chinese-American Art Faculty Association**

#### **INTRODUCTION**

**November 28, 2013** 

Chinese-American Art Faculty Association is to encourage and promote exchange opportunities related to visual arts higher education in both China and the United States. It provides a platform for this community to engage cultural dialogs, exchange creative ideas, and share teaching experiences, through exhibitions, conferences and symposiums.

#### **Organizational Structure**

The members are primarily US-based visual art professors of Chinese origin, who have considerable teaching experiences in both China and the United States.

Last committee calls for a members' group meeting to elect new committee members every two years, and nominates a new committee. The committee shall consist of five members. Each Committee member serves for two years, and will never be reelected over four years. All committee members are equal with one vote in the process of decision-making. The majority vote shall decide to adopt upcoming projects and policy for the association.

The chair of the committee will be responsible for the day-to-day operations of the Association and promulgate activities that meet the strategic goals and fiscal well being of the unit. The chair is responsible for addressing the purpose, goals, reputation, and visibility of the association; seeking and attaining external funding; developing appropriate collaborations with external constituencies; managing budgets and personnel; managing projects and overseeing programming; adhering to association policies and procedure; and working cooperatively with other members. A chair will be elected by members' group meeting and appointed by the committee.

The association will normally establish an advisory board to provide strategic oversight and direction. Board membership should include internal and external individuals to provide networking contacts for outreach and funding opportunities.

The committee will be responsible for submitting an annual report and a periodic program review to the advisory board and members' group meeting.

#### **Background**

Initiated and guided by Professor Yu Ji in October 2003, the "Across the Divide" was successfully held in its first exhibition at California State University,

Long Beach, named The First Exhibition and Symposium of the Chinese Art Faculty in American University.

Then, the continuing exhibitions were organized respectively by Professor Lampo Leong at The Columbia Art League of Missouri, by Professor Howard Tran at Lycoming College, PA, by Professor Josh Yu at Savannah College of Art and Design, by Professor Libei Liu at University of Texas, Austin, and by Professor Xiaohong Zhang at the University of Wisconsin Whitewater. Most recently, Professor Rebecca Ruige Xu has organized an exhibition at State University of Missouri, and Professor Xiaomiao Wang and Professor Shaoqian Zhang are currently organizing two new exhibitions at Oklahoma State University and in Southwestern Oklahoma State University. In November 2013, Professor Zhiyuan Cong successfully organizing the pilot symposium "American and Chinese Visual Arts Higher Education: A Comparative Dialogue" at William Patterson University. On October 21, 2013 the first project committee was elected at University of Wisconsin, Whitewater. Professor Ying Tan and Professor Yida Wang were elected to sever as Chair. Professor Lawrence Yun, Zhimin Guan and Howard Tran sever as the committee member. On November 8, 2013, the new committee was elected at William Paterson University. Professor Zhiyuan Cong severs as Chair and Professor Chung-Fan Chang, Lian Duan, Jiawei Gong, Xiaomiao Wang sever as member. On November 8, 2013, with several discussions among the committee members of two terms, the new committee has reached a consensus that the suitable name for this association would be "Chinese-American Art Faculty Association", which is proper for starting any substantial work at the earliest.

#### **Proposed Initiatives & Activities**

#### Develop Advisory Committee

The association will cultivate an active Advisory Committee and administration system. The advisory committee will be comprised of three groups of working professionals, which will contribute to the cultural, artistic, educational, and economic operations of the organization.

#### •Develop an Infrastructure for the Association

The administration system will ideally be composed of three positions: the committee Chair, four committee members and an Administrative Assistant.

### **•**Develop Web and Other Materials for Promotional and Fundraising Activities

It is planned to establish a strong web presence as a cost-effective method of sharing the activities of Chinese-American Art Faculty Association to national and international audience. Images and recordings can be displayed and events can be and reviewed. Additionally, a Web presence will help establish credibility and attract interest and participation from new audiences who seek an appreciation of the both art of Chinese and American. The association will maintain and update the CAAFA web site and create attractive and informational publicity and promotional materials. It will work with Institutional Advancement to develop proposals for funding to support the longevity of the organization and to recruit new members for future fundraisers and programs.

#### •Develop International Education Exchange Programs

These programs will include the visiting professor program and the International Graduate Study Program. Visiting artists will be invited to participate in exhibitions, lectures and demonstrations. Such an exchange

will establish reciprocity with artists and other universities to promote future intellectual and exchange between Chinese and American art and culture.

### •Develop International Art Exhibitions and Create Exhibition Space for membership Artists

Exhibition will be one of the important activities in the Association. The association will continue to organize international art exhibitions to promote the association artists, utilize local talent, and promote the association's role as part of the community. The association will curate art exhibitions from various artists and display them in different Universities in America. Subsequently, an exhibition catalogue with an introduction to the exhibition themes and interpretive essays on the history, culture, and arts of the period or region. Conferences or lectures will be presented and receptions will be hosted during these exhibitions.

#### **Activities and Budget -2014**

#### Exhibition and Symposium at New York City in November 2014

This exhibition and symposium will be co-sponsored by the Center for Chinese Art at William Paterson University of New Jersey, Asian Cultural Center, and with Chinese-American Art Faculty Association. This is a four-day event that will include exhibition, demonstrations, panel discussions, lectures and presentations.

#### **Budget**

We are looking to have a grant of \$8,000 to initiate the program, and will continue to work on fundraising. We will ask for contributions and cooperation from co-sponsors to support the budget. All members will write proposals for their university's research grant for the activities.

# 中美高等美术 教育的比较及 思考

2013年11月7-8日, 由威廉由特森大学 (William Paterson University)中国 艺术中心、美术系、艺术与通讯学院和美国新泽西亚洲文化中心主办、 中美艺术教授协会(筹备会)协办的"对话:中美视觉艺术高等教育比 较" (American and Chinese Visual Arts Higher Education: A Comparative Dialogue)研讨会在美国新泽西的威廉帕特森大学举行,来自全美二十多所大学 的21位华裔美术教授参加了这次会议。

会议围绕几个议题展开:中美高等艺术教育所面临的挑战;两国艺术教育 理念和操作实践的优势与劣势,长处与短处,以及双方互补或兼容的可能 性和必要性;根据你在中美两国不同的艺术教育实践经验,根据两国不同 的教育体制和从教师到学生不同的文化背景情况,分析两国高等艺术教育 的共通性和差异性,并以实例作分析说明; 当今中美两国艺术教育最需解 决的问题,等。

会议的第一天,各位代表首先就自己的 教育背景、在中美的教学经历、自 己的作品和学生的作品作了介绍和交流。第二天会议以小组讨论和大会中 心发言两种形式展开。大家都有在中国和美国的教育背景和在中美高校从 事艺术教育工作的经验,相似的经历和共同的主题,使与会者久逢知己, 畅所欲言,各抒己见,研讨会为大家提供一个极佳的对话平台。

在当今的美国高校,艺术教育主要分为两度空间艺术-油画、版画、素 描、水彩、摄影等平面的架上绘画;三度空间艺术-雕塑、陶瓷、装置; 以及设计和艺术史论等课程与学科。随着科学技术的迅速发展,美术产业 化程度大大提高, 社会对设计和网络的需求增大, 后起的与科技相结合的 新生美术教学——数码、多媒体、动画艺术、设计类艺术,渐渐和纯绘画 课程并驾齐趋。研讨会以与会者的教学课程为依据,分2D、3D、设计、美 术史论四个小组,展开讨论。

与会议的2D绘画艺术的教授们,多数在中国完成其大学美术教育,到美国 继续修读美术专业并在美国高校获得教职。他们的艺术及教学,深受20世 纪中国绘画艺术的影响,又在以美国代表的西方环境中重新学习,融会贯 通,获得新的拓展。因此,中国现代美术在20世纪初起步、向西方学习、 之后渐渐与西方美术相融会的历程,是他们理解现代绘画艺术的途径。

代表2D组发言的关志民教授 (Minnesota State University Moorhead) 回顾了 20世纪中国绘画艺术与西画艺术相汇合的发展历程,以此为切入口,谈中美

谈中美绘画教育的联系和异同。他认为,让学生关注20世纪绘画的历程。 不只是为了绘画技巧和表达的问题,更主要是美术史能给他们提供一个开 阔的视野、丰富的参照系,让他们明白目前美术创作所处的位置,以此启 发他们自己的创作;还有,对20世纪优秀绘画作品的学习,有助于培养学 生对绘画的基本元素、构图构思的原则保持一种敏锐的感觉;同时,让他 们精通传统绘画技法和当代艺术的表达方法。

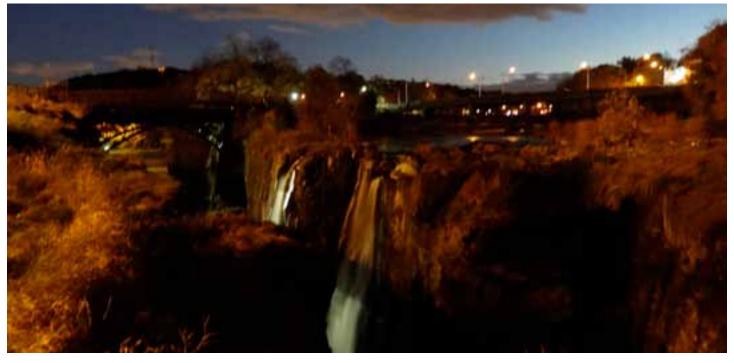
3D组代表、雕塑教授费明杰先生(William Paterson University),则就 所任的雕塑课程谈他自己的教学体会。他在威廉帕特森大学的教学,覆盖 雕塑教学的三个水平阶段。第一阶段是基本方法介绍和学习阶段,主要帮 助学生形成对三维物体及空间的认识和理解,重点教会学生能够使用简单 的工具和物质材料去雕刻一些物体,用简单的材料和方法去处理雕塑的形 体及其与周围环境的关系。对第二个水平阶段的学生,则引导他们更关注 更潜心于主题、材料和表达三方面的问题。对第三个水平阶段的学生,则 鼓励他们去研究自己感兴趣的主题,将学到的知识浓缩到主题上,并选择 他们感兴趣的材料,通过作品表现主题。费教授还结合他2006年在中国鲁 迅美术学院访问、讲学的经历,讨论了中美雕塑教学的异同。

多媒体、动漫/动画、平面设计组的代表谭力勤教授(Rutgers University)则主 要就中、美动画教育现状作比较。首先是中美动画教学课程设计的比较。 他认为在中国,实验动画教学多于产业动画教学;在美国,则以产业动画 为主体。中国的动画教学艺术功力深厚,强调民族特色和文化根基,强调 艺术实验性。他以北京大学数字美术专业学生的作品为例,证明这一点。 北美的动画教学则是技术与艺术并重,动画的技术含量高。北美的动画学 院大部分与美术学院分开,教学上以工作室方式展开。其次是中美的动画 教学对运动原理的理解、对动画的定义有很大差异。中国动画以"画"为 本,美国动画以"动"为本。再次是中美文化的差异性在动画片中也得到体 现。中国动画片强调寓教于乐,题材多采用有民族特色的历史故事或有唯 美主义特点的神话故事;而美国动画片则多是未来科学幻想片,而且他们 善于将他国的文化转换成美国式的主题,比如美国学生的作品《再见,明 天!》。谭教授认为,中美动画各有优长,互相取长补短,有利于两国动 画教学事业的发展。









美术理论/历史组代表的张禾教授(William Paterson University)就本组几位 教授的发言作了概述。美术史课,尤其是在美国课堂上讲授中国美术史, 需要借助西方的理论方法,采用英语语汇中一些合适的词,将只可意会难 以言传的中国古代艺术的一些东西表达出来。段炼教授(Concordia University Canada)以他的一堂课为例来说明这个问题。他运用原型研究、图像 研究和符号学的原理,讨论十八世纪日本浮世绘春宫画家铃木春信的《闺 室八景》和《风流闺室八景》,与中国古典山水画「潇湘八景」的关系, 指出铃木春信画中暗藏中国古典山水画「潇湘八景」的视觉渊源,说明中 国艺术是日本艺术的一个集体无意识渊源,中国艺术是日本艺术在视觉图 像和绘画理念方面的一个原型。进而说明存在文化隔阂的中、美艺术,如 何经由现代西方理论而加以诠释、贯通,并且运用于美国的课堂,使学生 从自己的文化想象角度理解中国古代的艺术。张禾教授也就如何运用英语 中确切的词,来向美国学生描述中国古代山水画的"笔墨"、"意象"的 含义问题,谈自己的教学经验。文化的差异性使美国的大学教学有自己的 特点。来自中国的正在威廉帕特森大学做访问学者的从事中国现代文学史 教学的姚玳玫教授(华南师范大学)则认为,美国大学的课堂有自己的特 点,比如重视启发式教育。学生发言踊跃。老师会腾出较多时间让学生发 言,在课堂上有较多的对话。另者,教师在课堂上讲授的知识量大。一堂 课讲下来, 讲很多内容。这就很需要学生在课外的学习和补充, 有利于培 养学生学习的自主自觉性。这些特点值得中国大学教育借鉴。

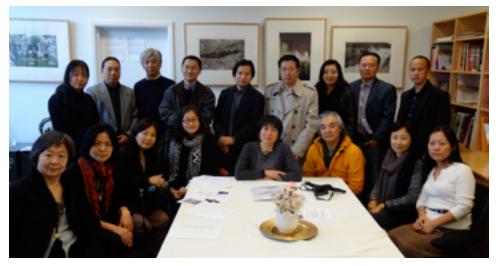
William Paterson University艺术与传媒学院院长摩尔Dean Deayl Moore 主持了研究会。中国住美国大使馆文化参赞王燕生出席研讨会并发表讲话,他说,"对中美艺术教育的比较,很多时候被引用作为中美文化的分歧的证据。我们不可否认,分歧是存在的,这也就是中国一直誓言尊重文化多样性,并鼓励不同文化间的对话与交流。"王参赞希望,研讨会不仅要去发现中美艺术教育间的差别,同时也要探讨该如何解决这一问题。











威廉帕特森大学中国艺术中心主任丛志远教授在研讨会结束宴会作总结发言,他说,我们中国艺术中心和亚洲文化中心联合组织此次研讨会就是要促进中美人民在文化、艺术和艺术教育方面的交流和理解,促进两国高校艺术教育的发展。丛指出当今中美在高校艺术课程设置的指导思想和目标上有很大区别。美国在1636年建立第一所私立大学-哈佛大学。而以美国公民素质教育为目标的高等艺术教育是在1862年莫日尔法令(The Morrill Act)颁发,大量公立大学的建立才开始,至1944年军人调整法案(The GI Bill)在国会通过,大量退伍军人和超过140亿政府资金涌向公立大学,美国的高等艺术教育从精英教育转变成全世界最强的公民素质教育。中国第一所艺术学校是1912年的上海美术专科学校,随后创建了北平艺专,杭州艺专和苏州艺专等艺术学校。尽管1949年以后这些学校都转变成公立大学,但艺术院校所追求的仍是一种精英教育。现在中国大量的高校扩招,艺术教育的方向已经改变,但其教育思想和课程设置仍然停留在培养专门艺术家精英教育的基础和思路之上。他为研讨会顺利和成功感到高兴,希望今后继续加强这方面的探讨和对话。

他衷心感谢中国领馆的支持,感谢校领导的帮助,感谢亚洲文化中心的合作,感谢全美中国教授艺术协会筹备委员会和教授们的积极参与和配合。

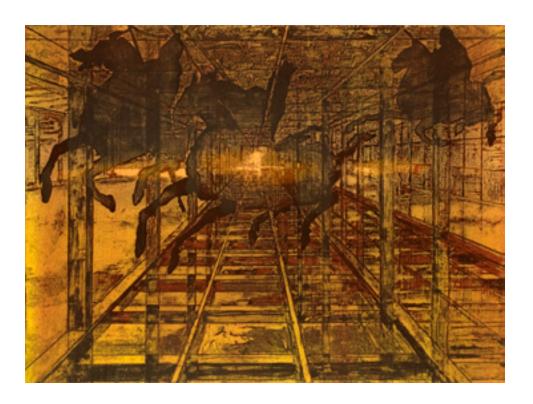

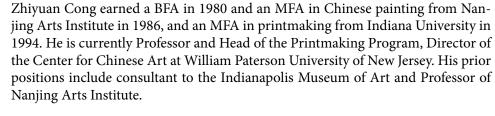

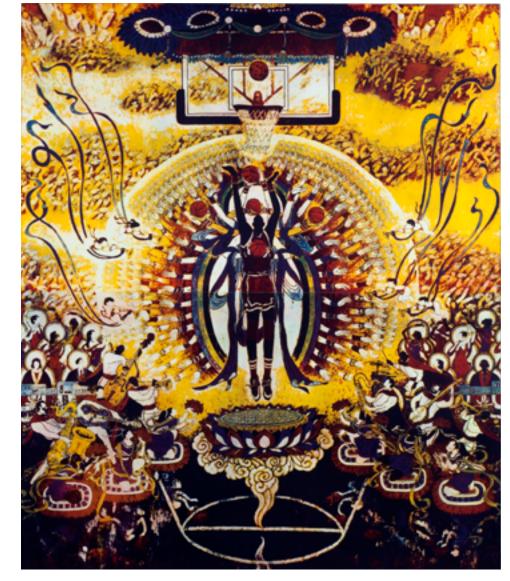


**張宗帆** 执行委员会委员 密西西比傑克遜州立大學

Lian Duan, art historian and art critic, is a senior lecturer of Concordia University in Montreal, Canada. His education is in art and literature. In art, he studied art history in MA program at Concordia University, and studied art education for MA and PhD degrees at the same university. In literature, he studied Western literature for an MA degree in China and studied literary theory for a PhD degree in China as well. In addition, he also studied classical Chinese literature in a graduate program at McGill University in Canada.

He has taught Chinese visual culture (art history), Chinese literature, and Chinese language at Concordia University, and also coordinated Chinese Program at this university since 2004. Before that, he taught comparative literature in the Chinese Dept at Sichuan University in China (1986-1990), and taught Chinese language in the East Asian Studies Dept at McGill University in Montreal as a TA and summer instructor (1995-1998). Then, he taught Chinese language, literature, art history, studio art, and culture courses at Carleton College (MN, 1998/99-2000), Drew University (NJ, 2000-2001), State University of New York at Albany (NY, 2001-2002), Mount Holyoke College (MA, 2002-2003), Marlboro College (VT, 2003), and Williams College (MA, 2003-2004) in the United States.

His research interest in art covers contemporary art, art theory, critical methodology, and visual cultural study. So far, he has published 11 books and numerous articles on these subjects in both English and Chinese.

He has also offered translation service to the Metropolitan Museum of Art and Lincoln Center for Performance Art in New York, and the Smithsonian Institution in Washington DC. For the Met, he proof-read and edited a part of the Chinese translation of "Museum Guide" and evaluated translators' qualification and their sample translations. For Lincoln Center and Smithsonian, he proof-read and edited the Chinese translation of the Tour Guide and Museum Introduction.

He has curated and organized art exhibitions in Montreal for Chinese artists from China, Montreal, and New York City. Currently, he is writing a research and teaching book in English on contemporary Chinese art, tentatively titled Lectures on Modern Chinese Art: Semiotic Iconology for Art History in a Study of Western Influence and Chinese Response.



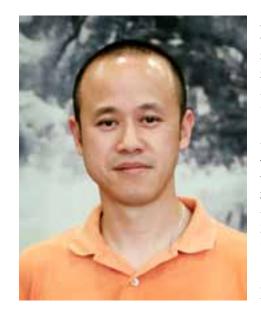

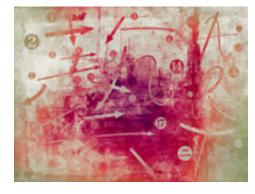

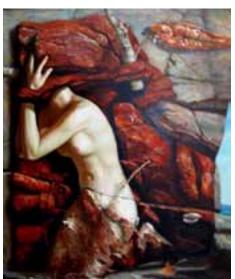

He came to the United States thereafter, and earned an MFA in painting and drawing from Fort Hays State University in 1998. Since then, he has been a professor of art at Minnesota State University Moorhead.
